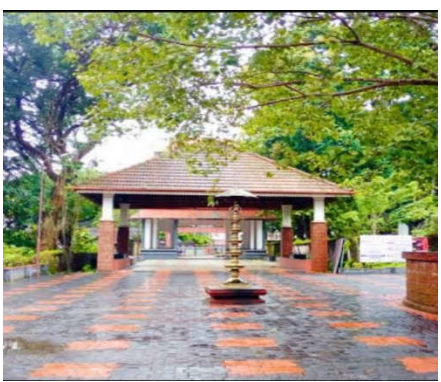

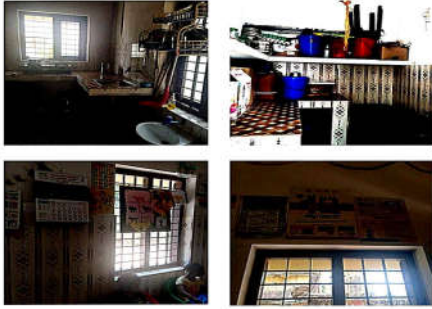

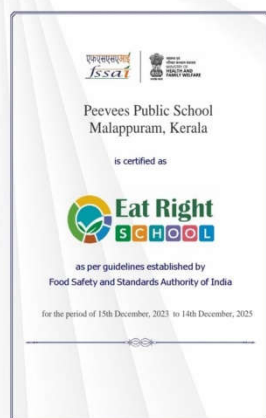

FOOD FORTIFICATION

Food Fortification Awareness Program to be conducted as a part of Eat Right Challenge - Phase III in Malappuram district commenced with registration at 9.30 am on 20.10.2023 at Chamber of Commerce Hall, Thazhempalam, Tirur Food Safety Circle. Noon meal workers of schools in Tirur municipality, teachers, Anganwadi teachers, teachers and students of Tirur Food Craft Institute participated in the program. Mrs. Deepthi UM, Kottakkal Food Safety Circle Officer, delivered the welcome address in the event. Malappuram District Food Safety Assistant Commissioner Shri Sujith Perera D officially inaugurated the function and Sri. Ismail, Principal, Tirur Food Craft Institute presided. Mr. Shahul Hameed, Superintendent of Food Craft Institute extended his greetings. Tirur Food Safety Circle Officer Mrs. Shamsiya MN conducted an awareness class on food fortification on the occasion. Her key points in the Session included that by doing food fortification, the quality and nutritional value of food items are increased, fortification doesn't change the color, smell and taste of the food item. Food labels with +F logo indicate fortification and they provide essential micronutrients required by the body, fortified rice distributed through public distribution system and noon meal programs contains fortified rice in 1:3 ratio, which contains fortified rice in chalky form and shouldn't be washed off or picked away. The students of Tirur Food Craft Institute distributed both fortified rice payasam (a sweet dish from Kerala) and plain rice payasam cooked at the institute to everyone. A response sheet was given to the audience to compare the color, taste, and smell of the rice of the two types of payasams and after tasting birth samples comments regarding the same were recorded in the response sheet. Manjeri Food Safety Circle Officer Mr. Abdul Rasheed P gave vote of thanks on the occasion
