The condition of seals on the container and the outer covering on receipt was as follows:-
The seal found correct and intact.

I found the sample to be **Plum Cake(proprietary food)** (category of the sample) falling under Regulation No. **2.12.1:(1)** of Food Safety and Standards (Food Product Standards and Food Additives) Regulations, 2011.
