Sujatha** (name of the Food Analyst) duly appointed under the provisions of Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006 (34 of 2006), for **Vadakara** circle (name of the local area) have received from the **Food Safety Officer, Vadakara circle** * a sample of **Bread** bearing Code number **3917** of Designated Officer of **Kozhikode** area* on **First day of September 2014** (date of receipt of sample) by courier for analysis.

The condition of seals on the container and the outer covering on receipt was as follows:-
The seal found correct and intact.

I found the sample to be **Bread** (category of the sample) falling under Regulation No. **2.4.15:2** of Food Safety and Standards (Food Product Standards and Food Additives) Regulations, 2011. The sample **was in a condition fit for analysis and has been analysed on **1.9.14 – 12.09.14** (give date of starting and completion of analysis) and the result of its analysis is given below/ **was not in a condition fit for analysis for the reason given below:

Reasons: Nil.

(i) Sample Description: The sample received in a company labelled plastic cover inside a transparent plastic cover tied with twine and sealed.

(ii) Physical Appearance: The sample consists of bread.

(iii) Label: Galaxy. Special Bread. Veg. logo-Present. Ingredients-Wheat, sugar, yeast, salt, Milk & Milk products. Permitted preservatives added. Net wt 300g. MRP (Incl. of all taxes): Nil. Packed on-Nil. Use by date: Nil.

Opinion***: The said sample is fungus infested and is therefore unsafe as per section 3(1)(zz(ii) & (x) of Food Safety and Standards Act 2006. I am further of the opinion that the said sample is not labelled in accordance with the requirements of the Regulation 2.2.2:10 (ii) of Food Safety and Standards (packaging and labelling) Regulation, 2011. Therefore the sample is also misbranded as per section 3.1 (zf) (c) (i) of Food Safety and Standards Act 2006.
